
Direct U.S. Action in Saudi-Led Coalition

Average number of U.S. refueling sorties per day since the Saudi-led coalition bombings began in March 2015. According to the United Nations, the vast majority of the 3,218 civilians that have been killed so far in Yemen are a result of the Saudi-led coalition.
