We are pleased to share with you the below data from this Defense Department report to Congress: "Defense Department Notification for Section 333 to Build the Capacity of the National Military or National-Level Security Forces of Cameroon, Chad, Kenya, Mauritania, Nigeria, Tunisia, and Uganda."

This report was submitted to the U.S. Senate Armed Services Committee on March 16, 2018, and the Committee has labeled this report as report number 529. We reviewed and copied down the data from this report at the U.S. Senate Armed Services Committee in April 2018.
