This letter is in response to section 2011 of Title 10, United States Code, which provides that the Secretary of Defense shall report to Congress annually regarding the training, and its associated expenses, of Special Operations Forces (SOF) with friendly foreign forces for the previous fiscal year. Enclosed is the report for FY 2004.

During FY 2004, a total of 64 Joint Combined Exchange Training (JCET) events in 34 countries were conducted under authority of 10 U.S.C. § 2011. Total DoD expenses to support these missions were \$11.99 million. More than 2,500 U.S. and 5,000 host nation personnel participated in these JCET events.

The primary purpose of the activities conducted under the provisions of section 2011 is SOF training. These deployments maintain critical SOF readiness in language, culture, combat and combat support, and instructor skills. Exercising these skills improves SOF capabilities in counterterrorism campaign, humanitarian assistance activities, non-combatant evacuation operations support, coalition activities, and peacekeeping training. Section 2011 training activities have become a complementary part of the geographic Combatant Commanders' regional strategy.

As an ancillary benefit of training SOF overseas, these deployments help to demonstrate U.S. capability, reassure allies and friends, promote regional cooperation and trust (especially in our war against terrorism), deter potential regional aggressors, build force interoperability, and maintain access to key host nation military personnel and important support facilities. Of significance, as we deal with countries struggling to develop democratic institutions, SOF set an example of a professional military under civilian control and demonstrate respect for and protection of human rights.

During FY 2004, the Department has continued to improve the visibility and civilian oversight of section 2011 activities. DoD procedures require that all activities

The DoD is confident that existing processes for oversight of section 2011 training events provide transparency and ensure JCETs are in harmony with U.S. foreign policy objectives.

## Introduction

U.S. Special Operations Forces (SOF) are conducting an ever increasing number of activities, in more locations and under a broader range of conditions. SOF have performed as the "Tip of the Spear" in this nation's commitment on the global war on terrorism (GWOT) in numerous parts of the world. Among these many activities are Joint Combined Exchange Training (JCET) deployments of SOF units and personnel, which are conducted under the provisions of 10 U.S.C. section 2011, in order to train U.S. SOF with friendly foreign nation forces. The primary purpose of these deployments is to train U.S. Special Operations Forces.

These JCET events, along with many other operational deployments, such as Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF) in Iraq, Operation Enduring Freedom (OEF) in Afghanistan, Pakistan, Uzbekistan, Yemen, the Horn of Africa, and Philippines; Desert Spring in Southwest Asia; Humanitarian Mine Action (HMA); Pan Sahel Initiative (PSI); Stabilization Force (SFOR) in Bosnia, are part of an overall greater employment of SOF. The regional combatant commanders and U.S. Ambassadors appreciate SOFs unique capabilities and how these capabilities support U.S. policy goals and concerns and also can complement their regional and country objectives. SOF display the strategic flexibility to adapt throughout the world and maintain the tactical proficiency required for operations with far-reaching political consequences. This performance is possible only by having intelligent, experienced, mature, and resourceful personnel, armed with cross-cultural communications skills, to interact successfully with U.S. country teams, other government agencies, non-governmental organizations, and foreign indigenous military organizations. JCETs continue to be an essential tool for ensuring SOF are fully trained in the languages, geographies, and cultural and communications skills necessary to support national security objectives.

The primary purpose of the JCET program is U.S. SOF training. An incidental benefit of the program for the geographic combatant commanders is a flexible, low-cost, low-signature complement to their regional strategies, which are based on the Secretary of Defense Security Cooperation Guidance and the President's National Security Strategy. SOF units exchange ideas, techniques, and experiences in unconventional military operations with foreign counterparts. SOF units actively seek JCET opportunities to perform regionally focused training, based upon mission essential tasks, to sharpen critical SOF mission essential task list (METL) skills. As an additional benefit, these activities often enhance U.S. influence in the host countries, providing an invaluable means of establishing critical military-to-military relationships with the host countries.

This report provides an overall summary of section 2011 deployments for Fiscal Year 2004. Additionally, the report provides an overview of SOF activities within each combatant command and the relationship of these activities to the geographic combatant commander's regional strategy. Also included is a summary of the type of training conducted and detailed information for each country deployment. A summary of classified deployments is contained in the classified annex.

## U.S. Central Command (USCENTCOM) and Special Operations Command, Central (SOCCENT)

The U.S. Central Command (USCENTCOM) is assigned an area of responsibility (AOR) that includes 25 nations, covering an area larger than the continental United States. The USCENTCOM AOR is one of the most diverse in the world. It is the birthplace of Judaism, Christianity, and Islam; has a population of more than 530 million people; and is divided into 18 different ethnic groups, 420 tribal groupings, seven major languages, and hundreds of dialects. Nearly two-thirds of the world's oil reserves and key maritime trade routes are located within this AOR. Thus, the security of the region has far-reaching implications for the international community. Security interests for the United States include a critical set of objectives. First, and most importantly, we must win the War on Terrorism in the USCENTCOM AOR. We must counter weapons of mass destruction and their proliferation, terrorism, narcotics trafficking, and environmental damage and disease. Second, we must ensure the security of U.S. citizens and property abroad. Third, we must foster human rights across the region, but with a special emphasis on secure and stable states. Fourth, we must promote the security of regional friends and a comprehensive Middle East peace. And last, we must maintain access to oil supplies and commercial markets, and ensure freedom of navigation.

To meet the diverse challenges of the AOR, USCENTCOM pursues a multi-faceted theater strategy to promote stability, deter conflict, and defeat regional aggression. The overall strategy takes into consideration the diverse cultural aspects of the region and the varying capabilities of the region's militaries. States are grouped into three sub-regions to increase understanding, identify areas for mutual cooperation, and leverage interaction with certain key states whose influence extends between sub-regions within the command's AOR. It is a flexible strategy that is particularly well suited to protecting our nation's security interests in the Central Region. The strategy capitalizes on mutual trust and working relationships forged over the last half century and builds on the success of Operations Desert Storm, Enduring Freedom, and Iraqi Freedom. Although USCENTCOM has the capability to act unilaterally to defend U.S. regional concerns, long-term U.S. goals are best achieved by working cooperatively with friendly regional populations in partnerships and coalitions. U.S. SOF are particularly well suited to initiate, then continue the development of these partnerships with friends across the region. In crises SOF also serve a crucial coordination function to ensure the coalition forces are interoperable and can fight as one.

To implement USCENTCOM's regional strategy and objectives, the command must have SOF capable of conducting a wide variety of operations in this diverse and difficult environment. The best training vehicle for SOF to achieve the desired level of competence and sophistication is through overseas JCET. During FY 2004, USCENTCOM conducted four (4) JCET events in three (3) countries.

The U.S. European Command (USEUCOM) is a large, dynamic theater that spans two continents: from Spitzbergen, Norway, to the Cape of Good Hope, South Africa; and from the Azores, Portugal, to the Eastern border of Turkey. Against this vast geography, USEUCOM stands ready to promote stability and thwart aggression throughout its AOR. To accomplish these theater strategic goals, the Commander, USEUCOM relies on SOF to provide the unconventional military options essential to the theater strategy of military-to-military activities and preparedness.

Special Operations Command, Europe (SOCEUR) is USEUCOM's headquarters for unconventional military operations. It is a joint military organization, which consists of Army, Air Force, and Navy SOF units resident in Europe and deployed from the continental United States. From these assets, SOCEUR forms multiple special operations task forces capable of conducting special operations throughout the USEUCOM AOR. SOCEUR provides the tools to engage friends and adversaries, respond to crises, and prepare for the future, in areas that require the unconventional approach that only SOF provide. SOCEUR participated in 16 JCET events in 9 countries during FY 2004.

The JCET program for maintaining and enhancing SOF skills and readiness is critical to USEUCOM's capability to prepare and conduct a wide variety of missions. SOCEUR's interaction focuses on the SOF-unique task of organizing and training indigenous forces, in support of USEUCOM strategic objectives. By interacting with foreign military counterparts, U.S. forces impart a sense of military professionalism, which reflects our nation's firm democratic principles and traditions. Most important, U.S. SOF gain valuable training and experience from their overseas engagements. In effect, SOF are USEUCOM's friendly assets in foreign countries, preparing the way for conventional contingency task forces as may be necessary.

Joint Special Operations Task Forces in USEUCOM display the strategic flexibility to adapt throughout this vast AOR and the tactical precision required for operations with far-reaching political consequences. This performance is possible only by having intelligent, experienced, mature, and resourceful personnel, armed with cross-cultural communications skills, to interact with U.S. country teams, other government agencies, and non-government and foreign indigenous military organizations. JCET activities are a principal means of developing and sustaining these skills. ## U.S. Pacific Command (USPACOM) and Special Operations Command, Pacific (SOCPAC)

"Ready today and preparing for tomorrow, U.S. Pacific Command (USPACOM) enhances security and promotes peaceful development in the Asia-Pacific region by deterring aggression, responding to crises and fighting to win." The Commander, USPACOM's vision is "a Joint Command directing and coordinating the employment of U.S. Forces in peace, crisis or war to advance U.S. interests as an active player, partner, and beneficiary in pursuit of a secure, prosperous, and democratic Asia-Pacific community."

USPACOM's regional strategy is designed to accomplish three major goals: make conflicts and crises less likely during peacetime; resolve specific situations on terms that advance U.S. interests in times of crisis; and win quickly and decisively, with minimum loss of life and resources, during times of war. The Commander, USPACOM puts the preponderance of his resources into engagement and preparedness, which are the two ways he can make conflicts and crises less likely. Engagement is the security dialogue with nations in the region that allows USPACOM to resolve security concerns before they erupt into crises or conflict. Preparedness enables him to respond to crises or conflict and to dissuade potential adversaries from using force as a means of resolving disputes.

The USPACOM area of responsibility (AOR) encompasses over one-half of the earth's surface; approximately 105 million square miles (nearly 169 million square kilometers). The AOR traverses 16 time zones, from the west coast of the U.S. mainland to the east coast of Africa (excluding the waters north of five degrees south and west of 68 degrees east); from the Arctic to Antarctic; and includes the states of Hawaii and Alaska. Nearly 60 percent of the world's population lives in the AOR's 43 countries, 20 territories and possessions, and 10 U.S. territories.

Special Operations Command, Pacific (SOCPAC) is a subordinate unified command exercising operational control (OPCON) over Army, Navy, and Air Force Special Operations Forces (SOF) assigned to USPACOM. SOCPAC has theater-wide responsibility to train and employ joint SOF in support of USPACOM's operations and strategy, crisis response situations, and for deterrence or warfighting in a major theater war and smaller scale contingencies.

Commander, SOCPAC's goal is to have the most capable and relevant Special Operations Forces anywhere. SOCPAC forces are trained to provide a broad array of relevant capabilities, regardless of the nature of the crisis. Commander, SOCPAC provides the Commander, USPACOM with a wide range of options in support of operations throughout the theater. SOCPAC supports operations throughout the continuum of conflict, from peacetime through war and back to peacetime, with nine principal SOF missions: Direct Action (DA), Counterterrorism (CT), Foreign Internal Defense (FID), Unconventional Warfare (UW), Special Reconnaissance (SR), Psychological Operations (PSYOP), Civil Affairs (CA), Information Operations (IO), and Counterproliferation. continuum is the task to be properly organized, trained, and equipped for the spectrum of each of the principal missions or collateral Special Operations activities.

Commander, SOCPAC exercises OPCON over in-theater and augmentation SOF, and is designated by the Commander, USPACOM, as the Commander responsible for planning, coordinating, and conducting the Joint Combined Exchange Training (JCET) program in USPACOM. Consequently, an ancillary and highly beneficial feature of the JCET program is its contribution to the Commander, USPACOM Theater Security Cooperation (TSC) Plan.

SOCPAC proposed 48 JCET events in 15 different countries for Fiscal Year 2004 (FY 2004). Due to various reasons, including current U.S. policy restrictions, events in some of these countries were not executed (i.e., Indonesia), while other events were either rescinded or canceled at the request of the Host Nation or unavailability of U.S. SOF to support due to operational requirements (i.e., Republic of Korea, Brunei, and Papua New Guinea). At year's end, SOCPAC participated in 30 JCET events during FY 2004 in 14 countries. The SOF skill sets gained and refined during JCET events further enhance SOF capacity to conduct other international training events such as Humanitarian Mine Action (HMA) and Counter-Narco Terrorism (CNT) training, where SOF also obtain valuable training experience and cultural awareness. The additional benefits gained through these venues, in conjunction with JCET events, serve as the foundation for real-world contingency operations, when SOCPAC may be called upon by the Commander, USPACOM to establish JTF-510, or serve as a Joint Special Operations Task Force (JSOTF) under another USPACOM JTF.

The JCET program is an integral part of Commander, SOCPAC's role in the WOT. The program also allows the sharing of training and skills between SOF elements and their host nation counterparts, while improving SOF capabilities and demonstrating the Commander, USPACOM's commitment to constructive engagement. Although SOCPAC typically engages on the geographic fringes of the Pacific Theater, where conditions are normally austere and threats are, at best, uncertain, one certainty remains clear - that the Commander, USPACOM will always require an unconventional military option as a part of any future strategy. SOCPAC will provide that strategic option through superbly trained and fully ready SOF that have gained a great deal of their skill, confidence, regional expertise, and judgment through participation in JCET events in the USPACOM AOR.

USSOUTHCOM programs that foster trust, improve collective military capabilities, and promote democratic ideals. SOCSOUTH also supports Commander, USSOUTHCOM's theater objectives to maintain a free and open Panama Canal, aid in implementing all provisions of the Panama Canal Treaty, maintain readiness to conduct combat and peacetime operations, and protect U.S. lives and property.

SOCSOUTH and its SOF units provide Commander, USSOUTHCOM a flexible means of accomplishing a wide range of missions. As the only deployable headquarters in theater, SOCSOUTH has rapidly supported numerous regional contingencies. Many aspects of the training available through JCETs, which prepare SOF for other types of missions, including disaster relief operations and personnel recovery cannot be duplicated in a simulated training activity on a military base in the United States. Through JCET activities overseas, SOF can practice their skills in the geographic region and the cultural setting that provides the real-world stage on which SOF may have to act.
